

Hon'ble Minister Launches NBT Title "Quest for Swaraj"



Dr. Bhagwat Kishanrao Karad, Hon'ble Minister of State for Finance recalled contributions of a few princely States towards eradicating social evils and the roles their Kings played in the freedom movement of the country at the book release function of 'Quest For Swaraj: Historical Journey of a Nationalist Prince' authored by Dr. S C Misra and published by National Book Trust, India, held at the NBT Head Office in New Delhi on 16 June 2022.

Releasing the book, Dr. Karad said that books highlighting the contributions of unsung heroes of the Indian freedom struggle being published by NBT are a great way to familiarise the younger generations with sacrifices made for the independence of the nation. He further said that the book 'Quest for Swaraj: Historical Journey of a Nationalist Prince' would continue to guide the future generations and pays tribute to a revolutionary icon, Maharaja Kishan Singh.

Smt. Rohini Grewal, granddaughter of Maharaja Kishan Singh was the Guest of Honour at the event. She appreciated the efforts of the author in encapsulating the true essence of the Maharaja and his beliefs in the book. She further added that the impact of his efforts and achievements pertaining to women and marginalised sections of the society are still visible.

Dr. S C Mishra, author, said that it is probably for the first time that a serious attempt has been made to reveal the story of an unsung nationalist prince, Maharaja Kishan Singh.





Eminent lawyer Shri Dharam Gopal Chaturvedi, said that the book is about a prince who lived a dignified life undismayed by British interference. He added that the various welfare initiatives launched by the King have also been acknowledged by the Constitution of India through various amendments.


The book deals comprehensively with Maharaja Kishan Singh's efforts towards

Maharaja Kishan Singh's contribution to the nationalistic fervour in the Bharatpur state can be summarised mainly in four areas, viz. making serious efforts for the unification of the diverse sections of the indigenous society; enlightening peoples' mind through personal interaction and promotion of literary lore preserved in Hindi; liberalising the age-old undemocratic customs related to women and the depressed classes; and democratising the temper of the State's administration through the introduction of the scheme of 'Shashan Samiti Vidhan'.

Grow With Yoga: For a Better Tomorrow

With regular practice of Sūrya Namaskara Asana, the body becomes healthy, sound and energetic. All the organs and tissues become active and the secretion of hormones from endocrine glands become normal. Performing Sūrya Namaskara Asana in the early morning hours, facing towards the east is beneficial. Mostly this Asana is practiced on an empty stomach according to ease. While performing the 12 positions, if special attention is given to Paraka, Kumbhka and Recaka, you derive

maximum benefit from the practice.

This is an independent and complete exercise in itself. It has 12 different steps. It is known as a combination of 12 Asanas.

GENERAL RULES OF SURYA NAMASKARA ASANA

1. Surya Namaskara performed early in the morning is more beneficial. 2. Completing all 12 exercises of Surya Namaskara is called as one round. To get maximum benefit, you must do 10-15 rounds.

3. While performing its 12 exercises, one must be careful to follow Puraka, Kumbhaka and Recaka. Their meaning is as follows:

- Inhaling is known as 'Puraka'.
- Holding the breath is known as 'Kumbhaka'
- Exhaling is known as 'Recaka'.

4. We should not practice Surya Namaskara during illness. But, it can be done slowly under the guidance of the Yoga teacher.

Books published by NBT in regional languages like Garhwali, Nepali and Kumaoni as well as English and Hindi and other Indian languages were displayed at these exhibitions.


Pithoragarh, Uttarakhand


Book Review

Baba Kharak Singh and India’s Struggle for Freedom by Mohinder Singh

Baba Kharak Singh is a name that reverberate through pages of history yet little is known about his life and his efforts that led to the Indian nationalist movement gain momentum during

its freedom struggle against the oppressive British rule during the early 20th century.

This book brings to light many stories from the life and time of Baba Kharak Singh, presented with a fresh perspective to the average reader. There are accounts of him taking charge and moulding the course of events in the politics of modern Punjab, at various instances and proving himself as a leader. He led the Sikh community towards political consciousness and initiated Keys Morcha in 1922 which was one of the most successful agitations against British rule. Baba Kharak Singh greatly endeared himself to his countrymen and is still popularly remembered as the “Uncrowned king of the Sikhs”. This book affords the reader a rare insight into his personality as it includes a selection of speeches given by him on various occasions.
