NBT to Oragnize 30th Edition of New Delhi World Book Fair 2022

ational Book Trust, India is organising the 30th edition of the New Delhi World Book Fair (NDWBF) from 8 - 16 January 2022 in the in-person format at the newly constructed halls at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. NDWBF organised annually by National Book Trust, India (under the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India) is one of the prestigious and largest book events in the Afro-Asian region and has acquired a high reputation among the international publishing industry.

Organised since 1972, the NDWBF will be celebrating its 50th year in 2022 with photo exhibition around the 50 years of the journey. The theme for this year is "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav" - the 75 years of Indian Independence, which will see various panel discussions, book exhibitions, photo exhibition, book releases and discussions in the specially-designed Theme Pavilion.

With France as the guest country, the book lovers will be able to enjoy literature of France as well as other countries at the Foreign Pavilion, and a number of literary events will also take place at the International Events Corner. NDWBF organises a number of literary and cultural programmes during the Fair, which include Author's Corners, Seminars, Discussions, Workshops, etc. In addition, there will be the B2B forums, viz. CeoSpeak and New Delhi Rights Table, where publishers from across the world exchange translation rights and other business deals related to publishing. The New Delhi Rights Table will take place on 10 and 11 January 2022. The unique format of this event enables exhibitors to book their own Rights Table, meet each other, present their products and ideas, and also finalize their interests and agreements for transfer of translation and other rights of books available in English, Hindi and other Indian languages.

The Fair will also have a dedicated Children's Pavilion

where children from all parts of the country can visit and take part in activities and workshops held every day, and also meet their favourite authors and illustrators. Conducted by renowned writers and illustrators and also professionals from education and publishing fields, these activities see huge participation by teachers and children from government and private schools/non-governmental organizations as well as those associated



with the children's literature or reading promotional activities.

This year a special Children's Authors' Corner and Yuva Corner will also be put up for showcasing the young talents. One of the first of its kind, the Child Authors' Corner will be put up for published Child Authors, who will discuss their books and talk about their inspiration to write, their role model authors, etc.

National Book Trust, India's Gyan Samvaad Kendra (Knowledge Communication Centre) – the first of its kind Public Library in the city was inaugurated today at Raj Nivas, Puducherry by the Hon'ble Lt Governor.

Inaugurating the Library on the occasion of 68th Liberation day, Honourable Lt. Governor of Puducherry Dr. Tamilisai Soundararajan, appreciated the initiative by NBT and said, "The library will prove immensely beneficial in providing information and assistance that is necessary for learning and progress of not just the children and youth but also the adult population of the UT."

The inauguration also saw the august presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Puducherry Shri N. Rangasamy, as Guest of Honour, Chief Secretary Shri Ashwani Kumar as well as Shri Yuvraj Malik, Director NBT, Ms. Anurupa Naik, Head, Library & Public Division French Institute of Pondicherry, Shri Sharad Mathur, Managing Director & CEO, Universal Sompo General Insurance Co. Ltd. and other senior officials.

Hon'ble Chief Minister of Puducherry Shri N. Rangasamy also congratulated NBT for its extensive work in promotion of book reading culture in the country. Speaking on the occasion, ShriYuvraj Malik, Director NBT said, "In tune with the government's vision to make India a reading society, the National Book Trust, India – in setting up of public libraries across the length and breadth of the country - aims to make books available to all as the first step towards accessibility and availability of reading material. The Knowledge Communication Centre (Gyan Samvaad Kendra) at Raj Nivas is provided with the best collections of books which will support education at all levels and also encourage the habit of reading."

Our objective is to bring improvement in the standard of basic education and whole learning process nationwide by strengthening infrastructure and providing basic facilities."

As a part of the unique concept by National Book Trust, India where Public Reading Spaces are developed in a new format promoting 360 degree learning for public at large, these Libraries - better known as the Knowledge Communication Centres - provide reading-related infrastructure, created especially at public spaces for all age groups, in order to provide a platform for all those who believe in the idea of Education as a Transformation tool for the society. Till date, National Book Trust, India has set-up about 15 such centres across the country.

The Knowledge Communication Centre at Raj Nivas has over 1000 titles in

Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, English, Urdu, Hindi and French, representing composite cultures of Puducherry. The Centre a digital learning zone (self-learning centre) and a special Children Reading Corner which has an attractive collection of age-appropriate books for pre-school, school students and teenagers, as well as a dedicated activity area for sessions like including storytelling, illustration workshops etc., and also a digital learning zone. Range of books include contributions of Freedom Fighters under Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav section, on health and wellness, and the classic literature of the languages spoken in the Union Territory. The Centre also has a special section for students & youth preparing for competitive exams.

The library also has collection of art and cultural depiction of Pondicherry through paintings prepared by Paint Pondicherry group. A team of Raj Nivas officials along with NBT officials created this wonderful reading space in 7 days.

The library will be open for the general public from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. every day, including holidays!

NBT at Frankfurt Book Fair 2021

rd Frankfurter Buchmesse (Frankfurt Book Fair) 2021, the first in-person post-Covid event, was held from 20 to 24 October 2021, under the motto "Re:connect -Welcome back to Frankfurt", with about 1,500 exhibitors from more than 70 countries and over 200 authors. The focus of FBF this year was reuniting with colleagues and authors from around the world. The National Book Trust, India has put up a collective stand showcasing 200 titles representing the work of 25 Indian publishers



which was inaugurated by Dr. Amit Telang, Hon'ble CGI, Frankfurt on 20th October, 2021.

The theme of the India stand was focussed on 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' with posters of 16 Stalwarts of Indian National Movement donning the exhibition panels of the Stand.

NBT Delegation comprising of Shri Kumar Vikram, Senior Editor and Shri Amit Kumar Singh, Deputy Director (Sales), had very fruitful meetings/interactions with publishers, distributors, rights managers, writers, librarians, book fair organisers and dignitaries etc of over 25 countries. The Delegation also had a detailed meeting with Dr Amit Telang, Hon'ble CGI, Frankfurt on the possibilities of book promotion in Germany.

The Stand also evoked interest from general visitors and readers of all age groups and sample copies of books were donated to libraries and schools of not only Frankfurt, but also to those situated at Vienna, Czech Republic, Afghanistan etc.

The inaugural session was followed by a lecture on translation by Prof. Rajesh Sharma, Head of Department of English and Publications Bureau, Punjabi University. Prof. Sharma talked highlighted the important things to be taken care of while translating books. He remarked that the translation should not



be word to word but should give the essence of the original text while keeping the structure of original text intact. He added that simple words should be used while translating the children's books.

During the workshop over 30 books in Hindi, published under Nehru Bal Pustakalay series were translated into Punjabi. The workshop was attended by 18 translators across the State.
