



2. Sealed quotations are invited for disposal of aforesaid three Exhibition Vans and one Staff Car (Innova) on the terms and conditions mentioned below. Interested parties may submitted their highest quotation in a sealed envelope with amount offered for each vehicle on the letter head duly signed in the enclosed proforma addressed to National Book Trust, India, Nehru Bhawan, 5 Institutional Area, Phase-II, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi – 110 070 and dropped in the Tender Box placed at the above address from 9.00 am to 3.30 pm by 02.09.2019. In case of cutting/ overwriting the bid will be rejected.
3. The four vehicles will be available for inspection from 11.00 AM to 3.00 PM on all working days from 21.08.2019 to 02.09.2019. The quotations received in time will be opened by the Tender Committee on 02.09.2019 at 4.00 PM in the committee Room of NBT Head office. The Bidders or their representative (not more than one) if they so desire may be present, at the time of opening of quotations.
4. Late Bids i.e. bids received after the specified time and date of receipt will not be considered.

5. The Bidders are required to submit their bid applications alongwith an Earnest Money Deposit of ₹25,000/- by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of **National Book Trust, India, New Delhi**.
6. The auction will be governed by the following conditions:-
- i. The successful bidder will be required to deposit the balance bid amount after adjustment of Earnest Money of ₹25,000/- latest within one week of opening of bids by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of **“National Book Trust, New Delhi”**.
 - ii. The delivery of the sold four vehicles will be handed over only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of identity and residential status (Ration Card/Voter Identity Card/ Aadhar Card in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms /companies).
 - iii. The successful bidder shall have to surrender the cut part of the chassis numbers to NBT after scrapping the vehicles. An undertaking to this effect will have to be submitted alongwith the quotation.
 - iv. The sold vehicles shall have to be removed by the successful bidder immediately at his own expenses.
 - v. The vehicles are being disposed off on as is where is basis and no guarantee for road worthiness or quality will be given by NBT.
 - vi. These vehicles having been scrapped will not ply on the road. Hence no Registration Certificate and ownership transfer documents will handed over the successful bidder.
 - vii. If the successful bidder withdraws his/her bid the Earnest Money will be forfeited.
 - viii. Subsequent to handing over possession of the auctioned vehicles, NBT will not be responsible for any legal issue related to these vehicles.
 - ix. NBT reserves the right to accept or reject any/all the quotations without assigning any reasons, whatsoever.
