This Bidding Documents is governed by the following terms and conditions:

1. The successful Bidder will be required to deposit Performance Security equal to 10% (ten percent) of the value quoted for the contract in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft/ Pay Order/ Bankers cheque drawn in favour of National Book Trust, India payable at New Delhi.
2. The Contractor will be responsible for satisfactory execution of the job and upkeep of each component of the structure by undertaking required repairs during the entire contract period at his own cost.
3. Any damage/loss caused to NBT on account of use of inferior material be indemnified by the contractor.
4. If the repairs/rectifications pointed out by NBT are not carried out by the Contractor, penalty of 20% on the Contractor's bill will be levied.
5. Payment to the Contractor subject to applicable taxes will be released on completion of each month on satisfactory report of the approved Committee with regard to the Structure erected.
6. The NBT and the Contractor will try to settle any dispute amicably and on mutual basis. If such efforts fail, all disputes will be subject to the Jurisdiction of Delhi Court only.
