



The Logo of the National Book Trust, India has been adapted from the sculpture (on the extreme left in the above visual) of Kalpa-Vriksha, the mythical tree which is supposed to possess the powers to fulfil the desires of anyone who sits under it. The motto

एकः सूते सकलम्

has been taken from Kalidasa's *Meghdutam*, signifying the purpose of the National Book Trust, India for striving to give everything desired in the world of books.
